RECYCLING INFORMATION

Recyclables will only be collected if they are are placed in, or next to, a blue box.

SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING PROGRAM: ALL TOGETHER NOW

- METAL Aluminum and steel food and beverage bottles and containers, foil and plates, EMPTY aerosol cans
- PAPER AND CARDBOARD Paper cups, fine print, paper, flyers, newspaper, books, egg cartons, magazines, envelopes, boxboard, brochures, and polycoat containers (ie. gable top, Tetra Pak, frozen juice containers, milk and juice cartons)
- GLASS Clear and coloured food and beverage bottles, jars and containers
- PLASTIC (#1 #7) Bottles, jugs, tubs, lids and rigid packaging and containers from food, beverage and household products (ie. shampoo, ice cream, yogurt, clear shells, bags with the symbol on it)

PLEASE RINSE CONTAINERS REMOVE CAPS - RECYCLE SEPARATELY NO NEED TO REMOVE LABELS

COLLECTION SCHEDULE

MONDAY: North of 7th Line and West of Highway 15.

TUESDAY: East of Highway 15 and North of Richmond Road.

THURSDAY: South of 7th Line and West of Highway 15 up to 4th Line Beckwith and then South of Richmond Road.

<u>Please note</u>: The only time collection is interrupted is on the statutory holidays of Christmas or New Year's Day.

INFORMATION FOR RESIDENTS

- All waste must be at the roadside by
 7:00 a.m. on the scheduled pick up day
- All garbage should be placed at the roadside in large garbage bags. NO LOOSE, SMALL WHITE GARBAGE BAGS. The garbage bags may be put at the roadside in garbage cans if desired.
- Each garbage bag must be visibly tagged with ONE Township of Beckwith garbage tag
- Do not place tags on garbage cans or reusable containers
- Each garbage bag can not weigh more than 15kg
- Do not leave garbage out overnight, unless secured in an animal-proof container.
- Residents receive 80 garbage tags per year (available January 1st). Additional tags may be purchased for \$2 per tag
- Anyone, other than the owner of the property, who plans on picking up tags, MUST HAVE WRITTEN PERMISSION FROM THE PROPERTY OWNER(S)

LARGE ITEM PICK-UP

- Any household garbage that does not fit in a large garbage bag or exceeds 15kg is considered a LARGE ITEM
- Examples of large items include: bundles of waste, couches, refrigerators (freon must be removed), televisions, mattresses, washers and dryers, refrigerators, stoves and hot water tanks etc.) Construction material will not be collected.
- Bundles of waste must be securely tied and must not exceed 1.5 m x 60 cm x 60 cm in dimension and 15 kg in weight
- Each large item requires 3 garbage tags
- Rolls of carpet must be securely bundled and must not exceed 1.5 m in length and 15 kg in weight
- Large item pick-up occurs the first full week (without a holiday) of April to October as listed below. ALL residents must place their large items at the roadside on Monday, regardless of their collection day.

2025 LARGE ITEM PICK-UP WEEKS

April 7 - 11
May 5 - 9
June 2 - 6
July 7 - 11
August 11 - 15
September 8 - 12
October 6 - 10

*Collection will take place between Monday and Friday

UNCOLLECTABLE WASTE

Items that will not be picked up include:

- Articles which are not bundled
- Automobiles, Ski-Doos, etc., or parts thereof
- Articles larger than 15 kg or 1.5 m in length
- Construction or manufacturing waste
- Patio doors or picture window frames with glass still in them
- Stones, earth, stumps, etc.
- Yard waste (take to dump yourself)
- Household hazardous waste
- Water pressure tanks or fire extinguishers
- Iron, steel or other scrap metals
- Tires
- Carcasses of any animal
- Liquid waste
- Medical waste
- Night soil and animal waste
- Any explosive or highly combustible material
- Any material that is stuck to the inside of the garbage can
- TVs, electronics, microwaves etc., should be brought to an Electronics Depot

Some uncollectible waste can be taken to the Beckwith Transfer Station located at 9271 Cavanagh Road (tel. 613-257-1195) or Glenview Iron and Metal located at 3954 Highway 43 (tel. 613-283-5230). This would be the responsibility of the homeowner. There will be a fee charged for all devices which are known to contain refrigerant that are not **DRAINED AND TAGGED BY A LICENSED TECHNICIAN**. This includes vehicles, refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners and dehumidifiers.
